A big Welcome to London

Interview with Congress President David Goldsmith

An interview with Professor David Goldsmith, Congress President, Consultant Nephrologist at the Renal Unit at Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Hospital, London, UK.

Professor Goldsmith, what role does the River Thames play during the years ERA-EDTA meetings?

Goldsmith: We have chosen the River Thames itself as the congress theme because it is emblematic of the slow and winding, but steady, course of medical progress. It is the second longest, and obviously, the best known river in our country and has influenced our society and culture a lot. Similarly, medicine has a long tradition and plays a very significant role in our modern society and economy.

Besides, there is also a practical reason of why we chose the Thames as the Congress theme: The ExCeL is located next to it, some halls even overlook the river. If the weather is

nice, our Congress visitors will enjoy the view and will probably spend their breaks walking by the river. Therefore, the Thames is somehow always present during the Congress.

Is there a reason or a talk that you would see as 2015 highlight of the Congress that no attendee should miss?

Goldsmith: The ERA-EDTA Scientific Committee has compiled an attractive programme reflecting all the key areas of nephrology. Therefore it is hard to choose what the highlights are – we have one highlight after another!

Personally I am immensely looking forward to the three plenary lectures – the presentations by Prof. Dr. J.L.L. Banfi (Amsterdam, Holland) on longevity and cardiovascular, by Prof. Thomas Drake (Amiens, France) on “Salt – a health problem?” and by Prof. George Baksi (Cambridge, USA), who will shed light on stem cells and parathyroid. Besides that, I am eager to attend the late-breaking presentations, to which the findings of new, promising studies will be presented. I do not want to give away too much in advance but it definitely is worth to attend this section on Friday!

Where do you see the main focus in the scientific programme of this year?

Goldsmith: As I pointed out before, the scientific programme has been meticulously prepared and organized by the Scientific Committee led by Professor Ziad Massy. As always it will allow for major coverage of the

main clinical areas of interest for practicing nephrologists and it will also feature cutting-edge scientific discoveries. “Translational” research has as usual a prominent part in the programme, and special thought and attention has been paid to chronic kidney disease, geriatric nephrology, and other important clinical areas as acute kidney injury and transplantation. Another highly innovative topic will be kidney regeneration and development. The latest approaches in this field – from using pluripotent stem cells to grow kidneys over the utilization of human nephron stem cells to repair broken ones to the use of renal progenitor cells to regenerate kidney function – will be presented and discussed.

After four years of preparation, the UK's fifth, and London's second, ERA-EDTA Congress is now upon us.

The Scientific Committee, chaired by the indefatigable Professor Ziad Massy, has done a superb job of producing a vibrant, rich and outstanding clinical-academic programme.

The Congress "kicks-off" (always questionable if someone from England should ever use a football metaphor!) with the CME day on Thursday 28th May 2015, which is the first day of the Congress (this is not to be regarded now as a pre-conference add-on). There are an amazing 20 different CME courses to choose from, many of them arising from the excellent work of the very successful ERA-EDTA Working Groups - and we would hope for considerably more than 5000 attendees.

We will then have a Welcome Ceremony that same evening - starting around 6pm on Thursday 28th May - featuring Professors Stewart Cameron and Sir John Savill, followed by a reception in the ExCeL Convention Centre.

Over the remaining time of the Congress - three more days - the Scientific Committee chaired by Professor Ziad Massy and the Paper Selection Committee (chaired by Professor Denis Fouque) have devised a marvellously rich and enticing Scientific and Clinical programme, featuring three early morning Plenary Sessions given by internationally distinctive and successful scientists and clinicians. Over the main meeting days, cutting-edge developments and fresh insights and knowledge will be shared by experts in the field covering the major clinical and research fields in renal physiology, pathology, general nephrology, acute kidney injury, dialysis and transplantation. There will be over 270 national and

international Invited Speakers, 20 CME courses, 32 Free communication sessions, 32 mini-lectures, and 16 industry-sponsored sessions.

52nd ERA-EDTA CONGRESS
LONDON 2015 MAY 28-31st

A special feature of the meeting in 2015 is the collaboration with the UK's Renal Association (founded in 1950, current President Professor Bruce Hendry) and the programme will reflect the distinctive flavours of nephrology where the UK has made major contributions. The detailed planning work with the UK Renal Association has been both enjoyable and harmonious and to both groups' benefit. Respecting the long tradition of the UK Renal Association, the Raine, Chandos and de Wardener lectures and awards will be given during the Congress.

A record number of abstracts were submitted - 2,675 in total - for this meeting, and this bodes well for overall attendance and for the quality of the scientific and clinical programme. Around 2000 abstracts have been selected for presentation (after rigorous and careful scoring), and 140 of these will be presented orally (the remainder being poster presentations). A good opportunity to discuss research in depth with the authors can be gained by visiting the presented posters at the allotted time slots when the researchers themselves are present.

The Lancet sessions, developed in close collaboration between our Society and The Lancet, will return following their very successful introduction in Amsterdam in 2014. Finally, in the late breaking clinical trial sessions, which will be given both orally and as posters, data will be presented on cutting-edge and impactful research. These are always great sessions.

Altogether, we feel that a truly outstanding programme has been put together that will allow delegates to increase their knowledge through interaction during the Congress with other participants and the many presenting experts.

After the meeting, especially for those of you who can stay a bit longer, London and the rest of the UK have so very many things to offer. London has a wealth of internationally famous and distinctive Museums, Concert Halls, Theatre and Shops to entice you. The rest of the United Kingdom also richly repays exploration.

We especially want and need to thank all of the people in the ERA-EDTA team who have worked tirelessly to facilitate this year's meeting.

Finally, we also want to encourage you to visit London, hoping you'll have a great and memorable time here.

Founded in 1950, The Renal Association is one of the oldest Societies of Nephrology, probably second only to the Société de Pathologie Rénale, which first met in Paris in 1949. Past Presidents of the Renal Association include Arnold Osman, Hugh de Wardener, David Kerr and Stewart Cameron. The Association's mission is to promote research, education and service improvements for the benefit of patients with kidney disease. Recognising the importance of the multidisciplinary team in healthcare delivery, the Association is affiliated with the British Renal Society, the umbrella organisation for healthcare and patient organisations with an interest in kidney disease.

The British Association of Paediatric Nephrology operates as a division of the Renal Association as does the Renal Registry, which collects data from 71 adult and 13 paediatric renal units. Participation in the Registry's audit is mandated through the National Health Service (NHS) National Service Specification and funded by a capitation fee levied on patients receiving renal replacement therapy. The Registry's database is open to researchers

and will expand rapidly over the next few years with the launch of the UK Renal Data Collaboration. Other initiatives include the National Registry of Rare Kidney Diseases (RaDaR), designed to collate data from patients with less common kidney conditions and PatientView, a web-based interface that allows patients to access their laboratory data and clinical records. The Registry, in partnership with NHS England, is currently conducting a national project aimed at preventing avoidable harm as a result of acute kidney injury. This 3-year programme of work will include the development of an alerting system based on laboratory data feeds. The annual scientific meeting is the highlight of Association's year and we are delighted to share the 2015 event with the ERA-EDTA. The Renal Association meeting is embedded within the conference with parallel sessions that will include our usual named lectures and award-winning presentations. There are almost 1000 members of the UK Renal Association, many of whom will be attending the conference, and all will be delighted to meet and help other delegates visiting our vibrant capital city.



High concentrations of phosphate are associated with retinopathy and death

A common side effect of chronic kidney disease (CKD) is a disturbed mineral balance. Uremic patients excrete only a reduced amount of phosphate, this is the reason why the serum phosphate levels increase. An early marker of the phosphate retention is FGF23, its serum levels are usually elevated before the serum phosphate levels begin to rise [1].

A newly published study [2] in Nephrology Dialysis Transplantation (NDT) showed that among individuals with moderate to severe CKD, higher serum phosphate (but not FGF23) was independently associated with more severe retinopathy and microvascular retinal venous dilatation. This may have a clinical implication, as retinopathy is a leading cause of vision loss in patients with diabetes, of whom many suffer from a reduced kidney function.

"So far, the associations of phosphate with the ocular vasculature had not been studied in detail", explains Prof. Carmine Zoccali, NDT Editor-in-Chief. "Therefore the study is very innovative and important – although the results are not that surprising". Why is that? "It is known that the disturbed mineral metabolism, especially high phosphate, high parathyroid hormone (PTH), but also very high and very low calcium levels are associated with vascular disease and mortality in CKD patients. It would be surprising, if the vessels in the eyes were not affected".

The COSMOS study [3], a 3-year, multicentre, open-cohort, prospective study carried out in 6,797 adult haemodialysis patients, has now provided further evidence of the association of serum phosphorus, calcium and PTH and mortality. It even suggests that controlling these biochemical parameters might result in a survival benefit. The study has been published in the latest issue of NDT, too.
