




Results


1. We provide a bachelor degree (~3 years)

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




Q2 Is a final exam required (oral or written) to become board certified Nephrologist in your Country?


Q3 Is a final exam required (oral or written) to become board certified Internist in your Country?


Q4 In your Country is there a standalone specialization with time limited duration only in 'Dialysis Medicine' with subsequent restriction of care for patients in a dialysis facility?






